**LITURGY & LIFE...**God writes straight with crooked line." We often say this to encourage ourselves in the darkness of personal, social or national disaster. Is it true? Witness unfaithful Israel. The people ignored the covenant & were humbled through exile, but more important, this national disaster showed them that their God was really God of all the earth, a profound theological shift. In the Gospel, Jesus instructs Nicodemus in the mystery of the cross, the ultimate crooked line: "so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." This week let us prepare for the Sacrament of Penance. Examine our own crooked life-line. Mark our turning points, encounters & choices that make all the difference. Talk to a confessor, then give thanks to God, who is "rich in mercy."
